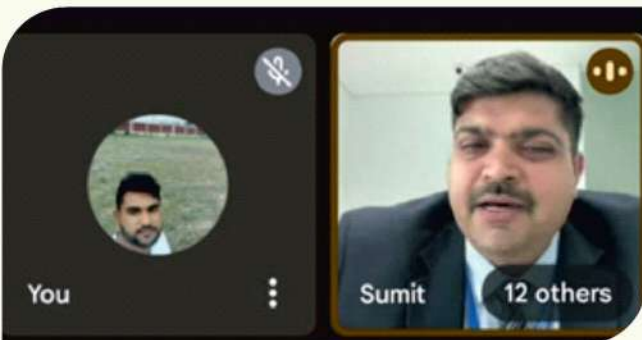

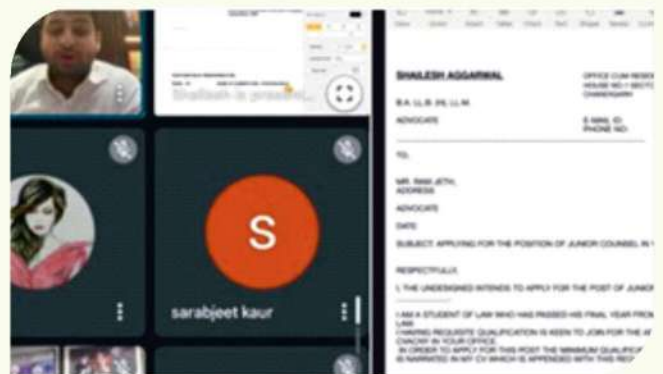


One Act Play on Domestic Violence for Anganwari workers : 26th August, 2025

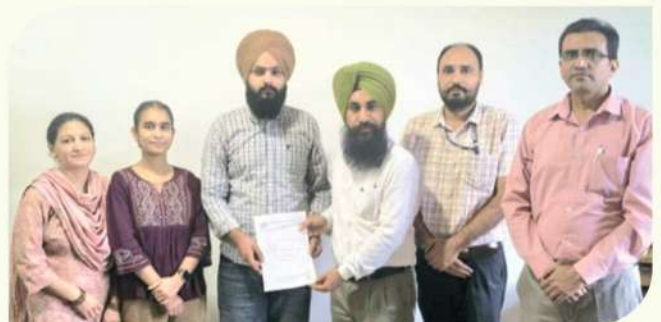

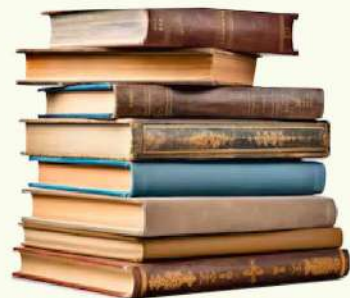
