### **Nrityakala 2026: 6th February, 2026**

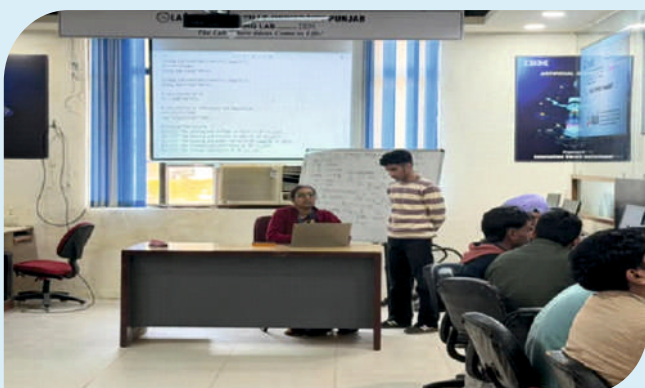
The school organized Nrityakala to provide students a platform to show case their talent and skills. The event helped to develop confidence and teamwork among the students.

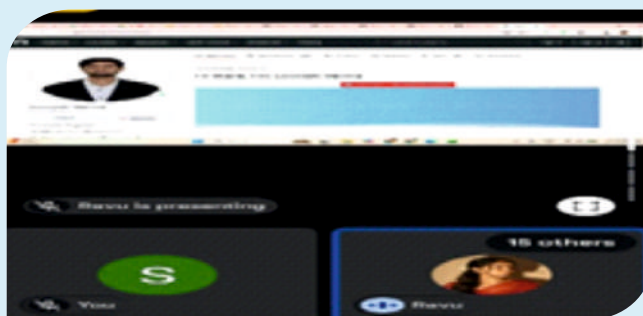


### Expert Lecture on Feminism : 11th February, 2026

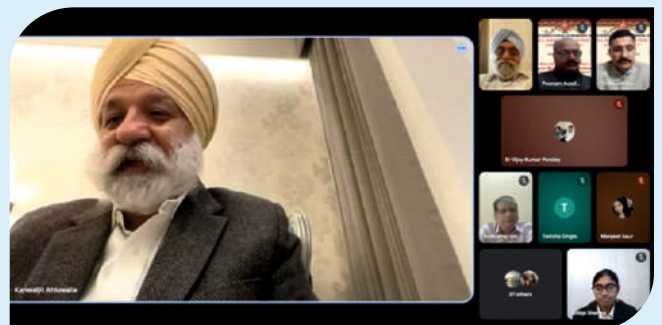


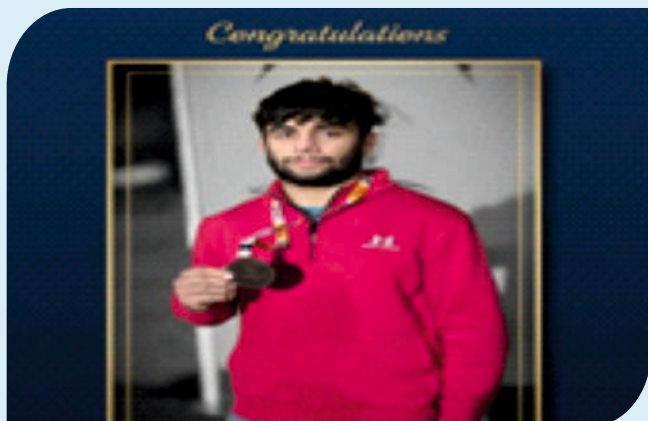
