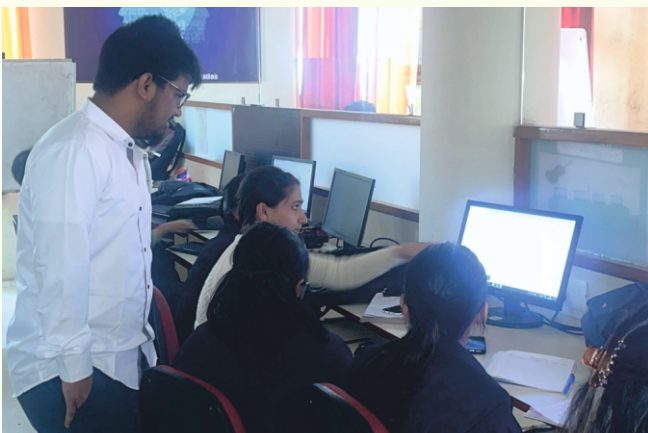

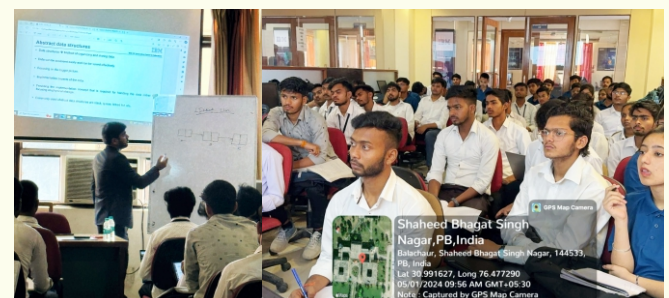
Special Lectures on Applied Statistics

Baisakhi celebration 12 April, 2024

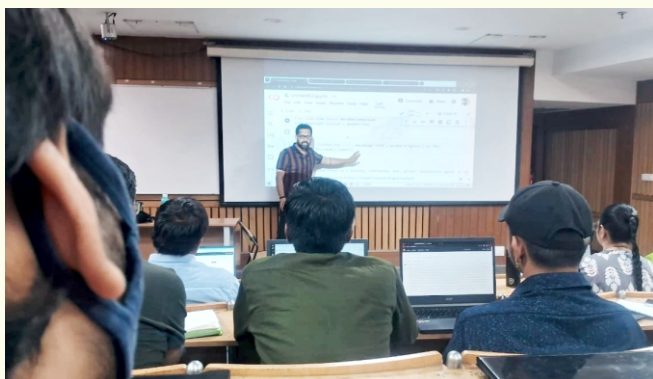

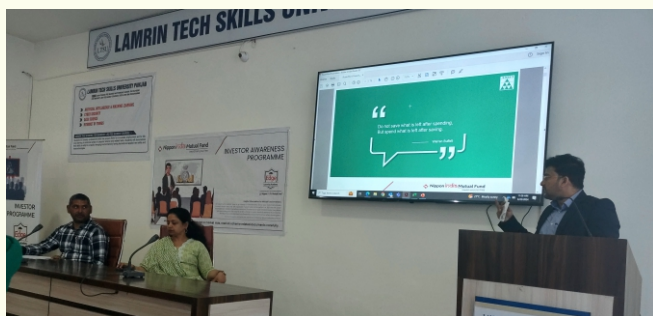

The poetry recitation competition was a melodic journey into the soul of Punjab's literary traditions.

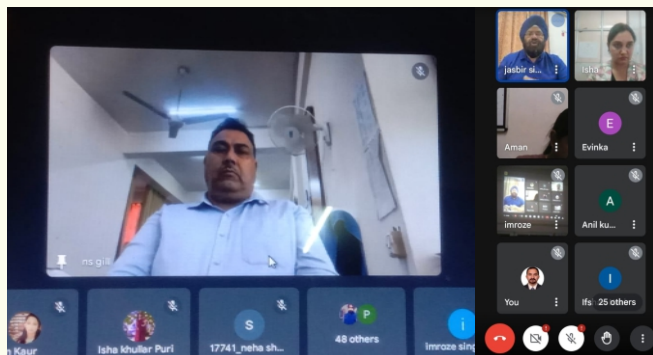
The quiz competition added an element of intellectual rigor to the festivities, with teams showcasing their knowledge across various domains.
